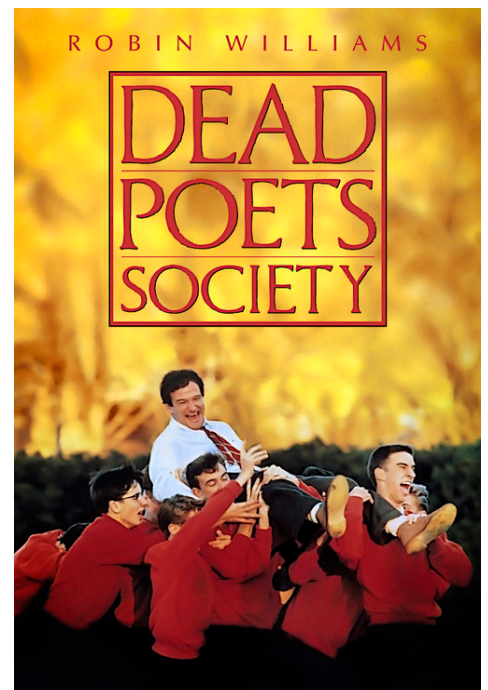
When: Saturday, August 16, 2014, 8:00pm (Movie and tribute begins at 9:00pm)

More: Just before the showing, Katie O' Kell, second-in-command at Serendipity, will deliver a tribute to the fallen actor.

"He was one of my favourite actors. The timing of our movie night, in some ways, could not be better. It will be an honour to pay tribute to him in the vineyard by saying a few words to the audience before screening what I consider one of his best films. He will be missed."

Dead Poets Society was released in 1989 and starred Williams as English teacher John Keating who inspires his students to a love of poetry and to seize the day. It won an Oscar for Best Screenplay in 1990, while Williams himself was nominated for an Oscar, a Golden Globe and a BAFTA for his portrayal of Keating.
