TASTING NOTES: This is our first white blend, and is a refreshing drink on a hot day. This wine has notes of white chocolate, pear, cantaloupe, lemon and grapefruit – a great, fruity summer sipper.

John Schreiner gave this wine a 90. He says “The varieties in this white blend are not disclosed on the label but my guess is that the wine is anchored with Viognier. Crisp and tangy, the wine begins with aromas of pear and pineapple. On the palate, there are flavours of green apples, green melon and apricot. The spine of minerality in the backbone is what makes me think there is Viognier here. The finish is lingering.”
