TASTING NOTES: A well-integrated wine with a long finish. This blend of Bordeaux grapes has hints of eucalyptus and smokey notes. It goes on to deliver juicy cherry, blackberry and dark fruits and finishes with flavours of mochachino.

REVIEWS:

John Schreiner gave this wine a score of 91-93. He says “This is the winery’s flagship Bordeaux blend, a complex wine with aromas of vanilla, plum and fig and with flavours of plum, figs and chocolate. The firm but ripe tannins frame a lovely core of sweet fruit flavours. The structure of this wine suggests it is a keeper with plenty of upside.”

“When I taste the Private Reserve Serenata I wonder why or if, it’s necessary to make any other wines at Serendipity. The flagship blend has it all with bright plummy fruit, good acidity and just the right mix of tannins. The oak is still a bit raw but it should come around in another year or two in bottle. The perfect bottle of red for roast beef.”
